## THE G30 PROGRAM

The **G30 International Program** at Nagoya University offers **10 undergraduate**, and **27 graduate degree programs** specifically designed for international students. These programs are **fully taught in English**, with no minimum Japanese language requirement at the time of enrollment. The G30 programs cover a wide range of disciplines, including **natural sciences, engineering, social sciences, law, and economics**. Some G30 Program courses also **welcome NUPACE and NU-EMI students!**



## 01 STUDY ABROAD OFFICE

## 02 NUPACE PROGRAM

The Nagoya University Program for Academic Exchange (NUPACE), is an **inbound exchange program** established in February 1996, and it has hosted a total of 3,248 international students from 41 countries/regions. The NUPACE program is **open to international students from select partner institutions** that have formed an exchange agreement with Nagoya University. The program welcomes **both undergraduate and graduate students for a semester or full academic year**. Students benefit from an **extensive selection of courses in their major**, the potential to conduct research under the guidance of an academic advisor, as well as **abundant opportunities to engage in cross-cultural activities**.


